


The Aim

discrimination or any form of
harassment and where our
students assume an increasing
responsibility for their learning
and behaviour.







Our Orthodox Greek School Community believes:

- Everyone has the right to feel comfortable and safe
- Everyone has the right to be recognised and valued
- Everyone must take responsibility for their own behaviour
- ∇ Everyone can experience success

Our School Rules:

There are some Basic School Rules that operate at all times that School is in progress:

- 1. Students will respect each other
- 2. Students will behave in a way that does not harass, harm or endanger
- 3. Students will use the playground, facilities and equipment in a thoughtful and caring manner
- 4. Students will share space, facilities and equipment equitably
- 5. Students will respect Staff members (teachers) and follow their directives
- 6. Students will follow classroom rules and take responsibility for their own behaviour

nappropriate Behaviour:

When a student does not follow the School Rules and displays inappropriate behaviour, a set of actions will be put into effect.

- 1. A warning will be given to the student
- 2. The student will be asked to <u>apologise</u> either verbally or written depending on the severity of the behaviour
- 3. The student will be asked to <u>re-do</u> any work that the teacher deems appropriate
- 4. If inappropriate behaviour continues, the student will be placed in timeout / isolation either within the class or within a buddy class
- 3. The student will be withdrawn from continuing participation in the current lesson
- 4. Further inappropriate behaviour will result in <u>involvement</u> of the School Principal
- 5. <u>Notification of Parents</u>. The student's parents will be advised of the student's inappropriate behaviour
- 6. Future strategies to be established
- 7. The final action that may be taken is Suspension / Expulsion from the school depending on the severity of the inappropriate behaviour

The School Principal will decide what course of action should be taken. If the problems are of a minor nature, then it will only be necessary for the teacher to talk to the student concerned and request for a written apology and the incident will be recorded.

solation:

When behaviour such as fighting, or harassment occurs during non-class times, student(s) will be placed immediately into isolation. Sitting silently in designated areas for a minimum of 15 minutes.

School Requirements:

Punctuation and attendance are required for all lessons and related events such as concerts, performances, End of Year School event, Annual Greek Independence Day Parade and other School functions. Parents are asked to please notify teachers of any absence or lateness.

Students are asked to be in class for all lessons unless permission has been given to leave or to be collected earlier by the students' parents. The students are to remain on school property during school hours unless written permission is given by the parents to the appropriate teacher and/or principal. Parents take full responsibility for allowing their child or children to leave the school grounds.

Teachers will provide supervision of all students during class lesson times, during recess, before and after lessons and until parent pick-up.

Teachers will normally arrive 10 – 15 minutes before the commencement of lessons to provide supervision.

Parents will co-operate fully with the teachers in picking up their children promptly after school.
